- Degree in aerospace, mechanical, electrical, mechatronics or similar engineering field
- Minimum 5 years of experience in aerospace, measurement technology, sensor technology or regulated engineering environments
- Experience in project or program management of technical development projects
- Good understanding of hardware development, prototyping, testing and qualification
- Experience with EN9100, EASA Part 21G or similar regulated environments is an advantage
- Knowledge of DO-160, DO-178, DO-254 or similar aerospace standards is a plus
- Experience with PLM, configuration management or engineering change management is an advantage
- Knowledge of APQP / PPAP or NPI gate processes is a plus
- Strong communication, organization and stakeholder management skills
- Eligibility to work on export-controlled, security-sensitive or defence-related aerospace projects is required. This may include nationality or security clearance requirements depending on customer and project scope.
